Dear Mr. Santos:

This letter is to inform you that a *Certificate of Early Termination for Special Parole*, was signed by the **Deirdre J. McDaniel, Case Services Administrator for the United States Parole Commission**. As of **February 13, 2017**, you are no longer required to report to the United States Probation Office. However, according to the Judgment, dated May 19, 1988, you were convicted of: *Possession with intent to distribute Cocaine*, in violation of 21 U.S.C. § 841, you are required by law to register as a Narcotics Offender.

1) Your responsibility to register as a narcotics offender terminates five (5) years after your discharge from the expiration date of supervision; 2) You must register within 30 days of coming into any city, country, and county in which you are located or reside with the law enforcement agency in the jurisdiction; and 3) Upon changing your location or place of residence, you must inform, in writing within 10 days, the law enforcement agency with which you last registered.
